- Why do we have existing division of powers in education between the federation and regions? Is it insufficient or redundant?
- Does the curriculum depend on the regional authority?

- What is the “unity of educational space”? Do other countries use similar political or legal concepts? Unity of educational space (in Russia) vs. educational equality (in other countries).
- What changes are required in this area?
